Purpose: To establish the board's vision for the center's public information and communication program.

It will be the policy of the board to keep the community informed of the objectives, achievements, needs and conditions of the center.

The board of trustees will seek to keep the citizens of the center regularly and thoroughly informed through all the channels of communication.

The people in this community are interested in their center as an extension of their homes; an extension which exists to furnish a special form of aid in the development of their children.

Therefore, the board will make every attempt to do the following.

- Keep the public informed regarding the policies, administration operation, objectives, educational program and successes or failures of the center and the needs of the center.
- Provide the means for furnishing full and accurate information, favorable and unfavorable, together with interpretation and explanation of the center plan and programs.

The director will supervise the public information program of the center. The central administration office will implement and coordinate the program.
